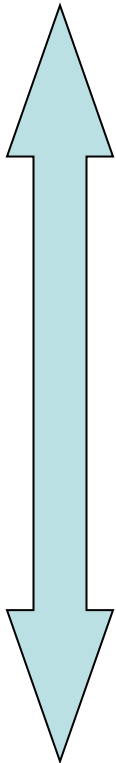

# WARP Trust Update

## Key points:

- Governance of WARP programme to move to the WARPs themselves (WOF)
- Sustainability needs critical mass
- Look for wider WARP opportunities at home and abroad - WARP Forum
- WARP MSP
  - Drive down costs for WARPs
  - Revenue to cover costs
- WARP site updated to a content management system
  - Lower cost to maintain



# WARP Managed Service Platform (MSP) - Update

- The WARP-MSP was launched at the 2008 Forum
- Proven to be a good demonstration platform for WARPs as it shows how to support all three services
- Used as the production WARP platform by IRISS since November 2008
- The default content has included issuing over 130 advisories on the most common infrastructure issues since November 2008
- The WARP-MSP continues to operate through to April 2010 with CPNI support
- A “self-install” version of the WARP-MSP software is being produced to allow it to be run self hosted



# Filtered Warnings Application Refresh

- Avius have been commissioned to produce V5.2 of FWA
- Bug fix release, addressing some minor issues identified over the last two years operation
- In addition support is being added for Windows 2008/ SQL Server 2008
- Some changes are being incorporated to support the “self-install” WARP-MSP mentioned earlier
- Due for release October 2009, will be provided as a free update to existing licensees
